In accordance with the Accreditation Council for Continuing Medical Education’s (ACCME’s) Standards for Commercial Support, all persons involved in the development of CME content are required to disclose to the accredited provider their **relevant financial relationships**. An individual has a relevant financial relationship if he or she **(or spouse/partner)** has a financial relationship in any amount occurring in the last 12 months that create a conflict of interest.
